<b>Results</b>	The IJS (ISU Judging System) will be used for all Divisions closed Marking  Results displayed or announced will remain provisional until the results are certified by the segment Referee and Technical Controller on the official result form.
<b>Membership Requirements</b>	At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant State Association (Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their State Association). The membership must be valid during the full competition period. <b>Coaches must be current members of APSA and their relevant ISA Member (ISA-25)</b>
<b>Insurance/Liability</b>	All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover. ISA & WAISA assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event. ISA recommends that any person traveling to an interstate event consider personal travel insurance.

	Coaches are expected to be insured via APSA and accredited.
<b>Eligibility to Compete</b>	Athletes must have passed the relevant ISA test level at the close of entries. All Entries must be accepted current WAISA members by close of entry
<b>Practice Sessions</b>	Official practices will not be available

<b>Entry Conditions</b>	Entries will not be considered complete unless accompanied by: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o Full Payment paid and all PPC and Music on entry through the WAISA website before the close of entry.</li> <li>o Late entries will be permitted for this event if time permits at double the entry fee.</li> </ul>

<b>Withdrawals</b>	Refund only with a medical certificate provided <b>before the draw. No refund is available after the draw.</b> Please refer to WAISA Policy 006 for refund details.

<b>Other Music file notes</b>	All competitors must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on CD or USB Drive, as specified. <b>Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs &amp; Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction.</b> Each program (short program, free skating, short dance, free dance) must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music.

	Two (2) files may be submitted on USB drive as specified by the LOC. The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of the event. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.	
<b>PPC</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All Planned Program Content (PPC) sheets are to be submitted online via the competition web page on or before the specified closing date.</li> <li>Synchronised categories to email PPC to Competition Convenor by close of entries.</li> <li>Each element is to be specified in its abbreviated form according to the ISU Judging System. A link to a list of abbreviations is included on the PPC Submission Form.</li> </ul>

<b>Awards/Trophies</b>	Trophies or Medals will be awarded to the first three place-getters of each division.	
<b>Working with Children Check</b>	All coaches, officials and volunteers working with children must have a current WWCC check.	
<b>Coach Accreditation and Membership</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Level 1 coaches and higher only are eligible to present skaters.</li> <li>Coaches must be current members of APSA, their ISA Member and wear accreditation ID at the event.</li> <li>Coaches intending to present skaters are required to register via the Coach JotForm and provide confirmation of the following documents. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>APSA Accreditation</li> <li>Working with Children Card or letter of confirmation</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	
<b>Volunteering</b>	Volunteers are essential to the successful running of the competition. Each registered skater/skater's family will be allocated a role on the family roster.

### PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEOGRAPHY

All private photographers and videographers must register at the Information/Registration desk on the day of the event.

Flash photography and camera lights are not permitted during practice sessions, warm-ups, or events, as they may pose a safety risk to skaters.

Photography and Video recording of practice sessions and official warm-ups is strictly prohibited.

Private photographers and videographers must not photograph or record children outside of their own family unless written permission has been obtained from the competitor's parent/caregiver.
