Technical Requirements	As per current ISU and ISA Technical Regulations refer: • ISU Sport Rules • ISU Communications • ISA Regulations and Communications
Results	The IJS (ISU Judging System) will be used for all categories. Results displayed or announced will remain provisional until the results are certified by the segment Referee and Technical Controller on the official result form.
Event Officials	Judge/s, Technical Controller, Technical Specialist/s, Data Operator, Video and Replay Operator for any scheduled events are by application to the ISA Judges and Officials Committee. Nominations for all Officials shall be submitted to the Chair, ISA Judges and Officials Committee no later than 28 days preceding the first day of the competition. The panel of Judges and Officials is managed by the ISA Judges and Officials Committee or their delegate.
Membership Requirements	At close of entries, all competitors must be full financial members of their relevant ISA Member and an affiliated club, except where no affiliated club exists. This requirement includes ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their ISA Member. The membership must be valid during the full competition period. Entries must include a valid ISA Member Membership number and Club membership number (except where no affiliated club exists), and the Proof of Age number (POA). Failure to comply with requirements may result in withdrawal from the event.

EVENT INFORMATION (continued)

Eligibility to Compete	1. Skaters/teams are to be nominated by their ISA Member for the entry to AFSC 2026. 2. Skaters must have passed the relevant ISA test level at close of entries. 3. Skaters/teams must meet all eligibility and competition requirements set out in the applicable ISA By-Laws, including the required minimum Total Element Score (TES) or Combined Total Element Score (CTES) as per: • ISA Communication 187 (Singles and Pair Skating) • ISA Communication 190 (Ice Dance and Solo Ice Dance) • ISA Communication 188 (Synchronized Skating) 4. Synchronized Skating Teams must meet the ISA requirements for Team Composition.
Insurance/Liability	All members of ISA Members are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover. ISA and The Western Australian Ice Skating Association Inc. assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event. ISA recommends that any person travelling to an interstate event consider personal travel insurance.

COMPETITION ENTRY DETAILS

Entry Process	1. ISA Members will provide the Organising Committee with preliminary numbers of entries by Wednesday, 30th September, 2026. 2. Entries will open on Thursday, 15th October, 2026, and will be submitted via the on-line registration system provided by the Organising committee. 3. All ISA Members will provide the Organising Committee with their nominations and reserves by Sunday, 1st November, 2026. 4. All ISA Members will be asked to confirm that the entrants are full Financial members in good standing, of both the ISA Member and a Club (except where no affiliated club exists). 5. All ISA Members must confirm that the skater/team has met all eligibility requirements including age eligibility; the prerequisite ISA test level requirements; team composition requirements; has achieved the required TES/CTES and the events at which the scores were achieved, as per: • ISA Communication 187 (Singles and Pair Skating) • ISA Communication 190 (Ice Dance and Solo Dance) • ISA Communication 188 (Synchronized Skating)
Payment Process	Payment will be on-line at time of entry.
Entry Conditions	Entries will not be considered complete unless accompanied by: • Proof of Age (POA) number • Music File – submitted to be received on entry • Planned Program Content (PPC) (with the exception of Pattern Dances) to be received on entry • Current Sport Integrity "Letter of History" • Passport size photo identification • Full payment paid on entry Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Committee however, the entry fee will be double.

COMPETITION ENTRY DETAILS (Continued)

Withdrawal	Withdrawal prior to the draw 1. Withdrawals must be received by the competition Convenor. 2. Refund will only be given if a medical certificate is provided <u>before the draw.</u> 3. 25% of the entry fee will be deducted from the refund to cover administration costs. 4. You will be required to upload a medical certificate if the withdrawal occurs before the draw and a refund is required. Withdrawal after the draw 1. No refunds permitted after the draw.
Music Information	Competition Music • All competitors/teams must submit a copy of their Music electronically via the on-line entry system. • Each program (Short Program/Free Skating and Pattern/Rhythm Dance/Free Dance) must be recorded on a separate file. • All music must be named as per the Standard File naming protocol: <u>Standard File Naming: Category_Segment_Name_RunTime</u> IJS Technical BasicNoviceMen_FS_DavidSmith_2m3s AdvNovDance_FD_JaneSmith_JohnDavis_3m10s JuniorWomen_SP_JaneSmith_2m45s AdultSynchro_FS_TeamMelody_3m30s • If not received by close of entries, the entry will be considered incomplete. • Music file names must follow the ISA Music Protocol. • All files must be submitted in the following format: MP3 • The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of the competition. • All music remains the property of the skater/team and will not be shared or re-used.

Music Information (Continued)	Backup Music Coaches of competitors/teams must have on hand at the official practice and events a backup copy of the competition Music as below: • Backup music must be on a USB • Strictly one (1) single music track per USB with a couple of seconds blank to cater for different music systems and time delays • Must be held by the coach at the barriers during Official Practice and Competition events. Music from phones is not permitted. Current ISU and ISA Rules Music (ISU Sports Rule 343 Singles Pair Skating and Ice Dance, and ISU Sports Rule 821 SYS): Please note paragraphs 2a), 2b), 3, 4 re Music Reproduction.
Planned Program Content (PPC) Forms	The PPCs are to be submitted via the on-line registration system. It is a requirement to submit a current PPC.
Awards/Trophies	Per ISA By-Law 608, Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be presented to the Champion and the second and third placed competitors respectively. Perpetual Trophies will be presented on ice for Singles, Pair Skating, Ice Dance and Solo Ice Dance; Awards and Shields for Synchronized Skating will be presented at the Synchronized Banquet.

Schedule	A schedule of events will be provided following the closing of entries and published on the event website and the WAISA Event Hub App.
Practice Sessions	Official practices will be offered for all categories as per the event schedule. Unofficial practices will be offered if time permits after the close of entries.
Anti-Doping Controls	Anti-Doping tests may be conducted in accordance with the ISA Anti-Doping Policy and ISU Anti-Doping Rules and Procedures. Competitors should be aware of the Anti-Doping rules, including requirements when leaving the venue after an event.
Sport Integrity Australia	All athletes are expected to undergo the following training module/s before entering the event. • Skaters 14 years and under: Clean Sport 101 • Skaters 15 years and above: Anti-Doping Fundamentals or Annual Update. Link to SIA e-Learning: Anti-Doping eLearning modules
Championship Titles	Per ISA By-Law 604, the title "Australian Champion" shall be awarded only to the persons who at the time of the commencement of the Australian Championships are: • Men and Women (Boys and Girls) who are Australian citizens or who have been ordinarily resident in Australia for a period of not less than one year, OR • A Pair or Ice Dance couple with at least one partner who is an Australian citizen, and the other partner must be a citizen or resident of the country of an ISU Member or has been ordinarily resident in Australia for a period of not less than one year, OR • Synchronized Teams with at least 75% of the team who are Australian citizens.
Banquets	Banquet arrangements will be provided separately for Singles, Pair Skating, Ice Dance, and Synchronized Skating. Further details, including venue, date, time and any relevant arrangements, will be communicated shortly through the WAISA Event Hub app.

ACCREDITATION	
Accreditation	All competitors are required to register their attendance at the Accreditation Desk. Accreditation Tags will only be issued to Synchronized Skating Teams, Officials, Guests and Volunteers After registering your attendance, you will be provided with a participation certificate and event gift. Accreditation will be available from official practice on the day of your first event. Entry for spectators will be free.
Coaches Accreditation	Coaches must register at the Accreditation Desk. It is now a requirement by Sports Integrity Australia (SIA) for event organisers to sight proof of the following: 1. APSA photo accreditation 2. ISA Member Coach Association membership 3. Working with Children card/letter 4. SIA Training History for Coaches Coaches are also required to provide proof of membership of an ISA Member Association that is valid during the full competition period – reference policy ISA-25. On confirmation of APSA Accreditation, Working with Children card/letter, SIA Training History, and proof of memberships of an ISA Member Association, coaches will obtain Championship accreditation. No unaccredited coaches or other support personnel of any description will be allowed rink-side during practice sessions or events. In the case of an international coach, the coach may make written application to APSA seeking endorsement for the provision of championship accreditation upon review of evidence of qualifications submitted in English. Coaches may not access the judging stand at any time during practices or events.
Synchronized Skating: Team Manager and Chaperone Accreditation	Accreditation will be provided to one (1) Team Manager. One (1) Chaperone pass will be provided per Synchronized Team.
