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OTHER NOTES

For the Shadow events 100% of the program must be completed in the shadow format. If the athletes are not in shadow for the entire program then they should be entered in the Team event. The Team event performance should be original, and express a theme, emotion or story. There is not limit to the number of jumps allowed in a program. However, jumps must have a meaning in relation to the theme. Solo, pair, dance or synchronized elements also must have a meaning within the theme.
