**POLICY**

No perpetual trophy may not be taken out of Western Australia.

- 1 To be considered for the Most Improved Athlete of the Year State level and National level trophies, competitors must have competed in both short and free skate programs (where applicable) in the Mary-Ellen Holland and Spring Challenge/Western Australian Championships competitions. If the criteria is not met, the trophy will not be awarded.
- 2 The Mary Ellen Holland State level and National level trophies will be awarded at the discretion of the family of the trophy sponsor to the best performance at State level and the best performance at National level at the Mary Ellen Holland competition.
- 3 The Les Latham Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the most outstanding performance in the singles division at the Les Latham competition.
- 4 The Simon Waller Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the team/shadow division at the Les Latham competition.

If the criteria is not met, the trophies may not be awarded.
