# Technical Element and Technical Rule Requirements for Singles, Pair Skating and Non-ISU Ice Dance and Solo Ice Dance Competitions held in Australia from 1 February 2025

(This communication replaces ISA Communication 160)

**Date Approved:** January 2025 **Effective Start Date:** 1 February 2025

#### 1. Purpose of the Communication

To advise and confirm technical element requirements and technical rules to be used for categories that have seasonal elements for ISA Member and club competitions between 1 February 2025 to 30 June 2025.

#### 2. Application of the Communication

For all ISA Member and club competitions including Champ Series hosted between 1 February 2025 and 30 June 2025.

Please Note: Any ISU international events in Australia (e.g. Oceania) or overseas before 1 July 2025 will follow 2024/2025 ISU season technical elements and technical rules as published by ISU.

#### 3. Communication Details

As per ISA By-Law 600, the next ISU seasonal elements as announced in ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules and published ISA seasonal elements will take effect in Australia from 1 February each year. This will apply to ISA Member Competitions including affiliated club competitions.

Technical Element requirements below to take effect from 1 February 2025 for ISA Member and club competitions.

#### ISU RULE 611 (2025/2026 group)

## Junior Men Short Program 2025-2026

- a) Double or triple Axel Paulsen;
- b) Double or triple Loop jump;
- Jump combination consisting of a double and a triple jump or two triple jumps;
- d) Flying sit spin;
- e) Camel spin with only one change of foot;
- f) Spin combination with only one change of foot;
- g) Step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

### Junior Women Short Program 2025-2026

- a) Double Axel Paulsen;
- b) Double or triple <u>Loop</u> jump;
- Jump combination consisting of two double jumps or one double and one triple jump or two triple jumps;
- d) Flying sit spin;
- e) Layback / sideways leaning spin or <u>camel</u> spin without change of foot;
- f) Spin combination with only one change of foot;
- g) Step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

#### ISU RULE 620 (2025/2026 group)

## Junior Pair Short Program 2025-2026

- a) Any Lasso lift take-off (Group Five);
- b) Twist lift (double or triple);
- Double or triple toe loop or Flip/Lutz throw iump:
- d) Double loop or double Axel solo jump;
- e) Solo spin combination with only one change of foot;
- f) Death spiral backward inside;
- g) Step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

## Senior Pair Short Program 2025-2026

- a) Any Lasso lift take-off (Group Five);
- b) Twist lift (double or triple);
- c) Throw jump (double or triple);
- d) Solo jump (double or triple);
- e) Solo spin combination with only one change of foot;
- f) Death spiral backward inside;
- g) Step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.
- Other than the above-mentioned changes, until further notice, all categories/disciplines for all ISA Member and club competitions will continue to follow 2024/25 season rules and elements until 30 June 2025. i.e.;
