Eligibility to Compete	Athletes must have passed the relevant ISA test level at the close of entries. Preparatory no test level required Eligibility to compete in Pre-Adult you must be 13 years as of 1 st July 2024. Maximin age 17 years. Adult Divisions detailed in the ISA Rule Book, Section 5.

Two (2) files may be submitted on USB drive as specified by the LOC.</p> <p>The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of the event. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.</p>
